Wetlandkeepers, Sea to Sky Corridor: Spring and Summer, 2010. Participate in these 2½-day educational field courses to learn the fundamentals of wetland conservation and monitoring. In 2010, courses will be offered at Cypress Mountain, Squamish, Whistler, and Pemberton.

Wetlands Institute, Kamloops: May 31–June 5, 2010. This 6-day course in the Kamloops area will provide participants with critical tools to conserve, restore,



and even create wetlands! Visiting several wetlands during the week, you will learn wetland mapping, species identification, how to construct a wetland, and stakeholder

dialogue and involvement techniques.

Wetlandkeepers, Vanderhoof: June 2010. Learn critical wetland conservation and remediation skills and become involved in a new stewardship group in Vanderhoof.
